Outline: We are currently in a boom of research in artificial intelligence (AI), mirrored by the publicly available tools now available. Researchers in a range of subjects are studying how AI can assist them, and Chat GPT, Playground AI and Craiyon are just some of the examples of AI that anyone can interact with online. One of the largest areas of AI research is healthcare. However, to successfully use AI in this setting, patients need to be able to trust they are still getting the best care.
